**DECISION NOTICE**

1. Permission to appeal is refused.
2. The heading of the strike out decision dated 6 December 2012 wrongly indicated that there was a second respondent. I correct the heading by deleting the reference to a second respondent.
3. The reasons for refusing permission to appeal are:-
  - (a) The procedure adopted by the Tribunal was not unfair.
  - (b) The reasoning in paras 10 and 11 of the Tribunal decision is correct.

Mr Fortun now refers to another set of papers but his refusal to accept the District Council's offer to help him navigate the extraordinary amount of material undermines his claim that other documents are held and means that there are no other steps which it would be reasonable for the Tribunal to compel the District Council to take.
