



**FIRST-TIER TRIBUNAL – GENERAL REGULATORY

**Case Management Note**

1. This appeal was registered by the Tribunal.
2. It was sent to the Information Commissioner who said that they would not be filing a Response as no decision had been made by the Information Commissioner which could be appealed.
3. Ms Antonescu was then asked to tell the Tribunal of any reasons why she believes that this Tribunal can deal with her case.
4. She was asked to give her reasons by 5<sup>th</sup> June 2013. I am aware that she had problems with her emails around that date, but as the Tribunal has received emails from her today (13<sup>th</sup> June 2013) I take it that these problems have been resolved.
5. I have considered the papers which the Tribunal has received from Ms Antonescu.

6. This Tribunal is able to deal with appeals by citizens against the Information Commissioner's Office Decision Notices concerning the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and Environmental Information Regulations 2004.
7. The papers that I have seen from Ms Antonescu make it clear that she had a difficult time when she was in Wiltshire.
8. They also make it clear that Ms Antonescu made a "Subject Access Request" to Wiltshire Council for her personal information to be disclosed to her.
9. This Tribunal does not have power to deal with matters under the Data Protection Act 1998 concerning subject access requests.
10. It is my decision that this Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to deal with Ms Antonescu's complaint.
11. I can see that Ms Antonescu commenced proceedings before the High Court against Wiltshire Council concerning her allegation that they had breached the Data Protection Act 1998, those proceedings were stayed on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2012.
12. I therefore do not consider it appropriate to transfer this appeal to another court.
13. I therefore strike out Ms Antonescu's case under Rule 8(2)(a) as the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction in relation to the proceedings.
